#### **March 4:** A Watching World

**Primary Scripture:** Acts 16:16-26

**Key Point:** Your response to rejection can bring people closer to God or push them away.

**Guided Questions:**

- Have you ever felt treated unfairly at school or with friends? What happened?
- Who do you think might be watching your life right now?
- Do you ever feel like we, as your family, treat you unfairly? What happened?
- How can you respond in a way that reflects God in the future?

#### **March 11:** How Are You So Calm?

**Primary Scripture:** Acts 27:18-26

**Key Point:** When everyone else panicked in the storm, Paul remained calm because he trusted God's promise. As believers, our peace amid stress should set us apart and point others to Christ.

**Guided Questions:**

- What's something that stressed you out this week?
- Have you ever seen your friends in the middle of difficult situations? How did they respond?
- Do you find it easy or difficult to stay calm when you're worried about a storm?
- Do you feel like you can confidently tell your friends about Jesus when they need Him?

#### **March 25:** Seek or Settle

**Primary Scripture:** Acts 17:10-14

**Key Point:** A life with God is not one of stagnation. His followers are called to actively and intentionally seek Him.

**Guided Questions:**

- Do you feel like you're actively seeking God?
- If someone asked you, "Do you really care about God?" how would you answer? Do your actions reflect your answer?
- Who do you know that really chases after God? What's different about them?
- How can we, as your family, encourage you to seek God?
