April 8, 2026: Life of Worship

Primary Scripture: Romans 12:1-2

Key Point: The Christian should live in a way that is holy and pleasing to God, living for God is the ultimate form of worship.

Guided Questions:

- What does it mean to live a "holy" life?
- Do you think it's hard to live differently than the people around you sometimes? What makes that difficult?
- Why do you think that God wants you to live differently than those around you?

April 15, 2026: Every Part Counts

Primary Scripture: Romans 12:3-8

Key Point: We all have different personalities, characteristics and gifts. These should be used to advance God's kingdom.

Guided Questions:

- What are some things that you're good at that can be used to build God's kingdom?
- Have you thought that some gifts are more important than others?
- How do you think the things you're good at could actually help other people or serve God?

April 29, 2026: Humility and Empathy (Justin Hill)

Primary Scripture: Romans 12:14-16

Key Point: The community that Christians are called into is not one of shallow acquaintanceships; but rather, one of depth, communion, and relationship. Additionally, Christians are to live counter-culturally in how they treat their enemies.

Guided Questions:

- Do you have friendships where you feel like you can be yourself?
- Why do you think humility is important in friendships? What happens when people only think about themselves?
- Is there someone in your life right now who might need encouragement or someone to listen to them? What do you think it could look like to care for them this week?
- Do you find it hard to be nice to others when they're mean to you? How can you change that?
