### **May 3, 2026**

**Primary Scripture:** Acts 3:1 to 4:31

**Key Point:** The early church prayed not for safety but for boldness. Consider how fear and comfort can sometimes prevent believers from living courageously for Christ.

**Guided Questions:**

- Why do you think it can be difficult to speak openly about faith today?
- What would it look like for our family to practice boldness in following Jesus?

### **May 10, 2026**

**Primary Scripture:** Acts 8:26-40 and Acts 10:1-48

**Key Point:** The gospel breaks down social, cultural, and ethnic barriers. God's kingdom includes people from every background and nation.

**Guided Questions:**

- What do these stories teach us about who the gospel is for?
- How can we reflect God's heart for all people in the way we treat others?

### **May 17, 2026**

**Primary Scripture:** Acts 12:1-24

**Key Point:** Human power cannot stop the advance of God's kingdom. Even in moments that appear dark or uncertain, God continues to work.

**Guided Questions:**

- Why do you think the church continued to grow even during persecution?
- How does remembering God's sovereignty help us trust Him during difficult seasons?
